Awards

Each section champion is eligible to nominate one team member to compete with the other three nominees in Present Around The World (PATW) Hong Kong Round in late July 2017. The Champion and the 1st runner-up of PATW Hong Kong Round will be awarded a free one-year IET membership, a trophy and cash prize of HK\$ 1,800 and HK\$ 1,200 respectively. The Champion will also be nominated to the Asia-Pacific Regional Final of PATW 2017 in Australia in August 2017.

Deliverables

Product

The "product" could be a model, prototype, photos or videos that demonstrate the project idea.

Abstract

No more than 200 words in English as a project idea introduction and summary of work. To be used as preliminary screening material (if applicable).

Presentation

A 10 minutes multimedia presentation in English which is followed by a 5 minutes Q&A session on the event day.

Judged on the project idea and presentability.

Exhibition Booth

Demonstration of project idea to our judges and public visitors by setting up an exhibition booth. The booth getting the most votes will win My Favourite Booth Award.
