Summary

This circular memorandum informs schools about the details of the services provided by the STEM Education Centre set up at the Arts and Technology Education Centre in Lok Fu effective from 26 October 2017.

Details

2. To further support schools to promote STEM education, the Education Bureau has set up a STEM Education Centre (Centre) on the **1/F of the Arts and Technology Education Centre at 145 Junction Road, Lok Fu, Kowloon** (Lok Fu MTR Station Exit B).

3. The following support services are available at the Centre:

Maker Space

The Maker Space in the Centre is equipped with more advanced equipment and tools. Teachers can conduct lessons related to STEM education, and students can work on related projects in the Maker Space. Schools interested in arranging teachers and students to make use of the Maker Space may make prior booking with the Centre.

Professional Development Programmes for Teachers

Programmes for curriculum leaders on planning and implementation of STEM Education, as well as programmes for teachers on using common equipment and tools for STEM education (such as 3D-printer and laser cutter, etc) will be organised by the Centre on a regular basis.

Student Learning Activities

A wide range of learning activities for primary and secondary students, including competitions related to STEM Education, will be organised by the Centre on a regular basis.
